

Outstanding 2015 Form 4 (Year 10) National Exam Results

We congratulate the Principal, staff and Form 4 students of Katoke -Lweru Secondary School (KLSS) for their excellent 2015 national exam results.

Key features were:

- 36 of the 68 students (53%) achieved in the top Division 1 or 2 levels
- Achieved 19/192 schools in region (top 10%) and 202/3452 schools nationally (top 6%)
- Achieved in top 3.5% in English nationally
- Achieved in top 4.5% in Swahili nationally
- Achieved in top 4.9% in Biology, and
- Achieved in top 5.7% in Mathematics
- No students failed the national exams

Rowena Bragg (Principal) notes that the strong academic results are but one indicator of the whole-person quality education approach that is being developed at Katoke. The school seeks to develop young people who can problem solve, think, reason, work through issues and aspire to see the possibilities and opportunities to serve their communities and nation. The students' personal development in the context of a Christian world-view is encouraged and fostered throughout their time at KLSS.

We are also pleased to report that in the Form 2 national exams, our student, Idda Raulian, came first passing with a perfect GPA of 5.0. This puts Idda among the top students of the nation.
